

# PGDM Admission 2019

## FAQ's

**1) What is the eligibility criteria for applying for PGDM program at NLDIMSR?**

- The candidate must have passed a bachelor's degree examination with minimum of 50% in graduation from any recognized university under UGC. At the time of application the candidate may be appearing for his final semester of graduation, but for securing admission he/she must be a graduate with minimum 50% marks.
- The candidate must have appeared for any of the 6 written entrance exams for MBA viz; CAT, XAT, MHCET, CMAT, ATMA, or MAT. The institute does not have its own written entrance exam (aptitude test) for PGDM admissions.

**2) Is the program officially recognized under AICTE?**

Yes, the program is approved by AICTE.

**3) What is the duration of this program?**

PGDM is a two years full time program, comprising of four semesters (2 semesters per year).

**4) What are the specializations being offered in PGDM?**

The Specializations offered are:

- Marketing
- Finance
- HR

**5) How many seats are available for PGDM program?**

There are total 120 seats for this program:

- Finance :60
- Marketing: 40
- Human Resource:20

**6) When & How can I apply for this program?**

The application for PGDM 2019 is online. You need to fill up your details online and have the privilege of choosing your own GD-PI date and time. Applicant can apply online from 14<sup>th</sup> of January 2019 on the link mentioned below:

**7) When will the GD/PI process for PGDM admission begin?**

The GD/PI process for PGDM admission would be held from 27 April to 8 May 2019.

**8) How can I select my GD/PI date?**

You need to apply for the program online. Upon successful payment of PGDM application fee, and once you fill up your profile details completely, you can select the date & time slots as per your convenience.

**9) Can the GD/PI date be changed?**

No, the GD/PI date once chosen cannot be changed. (However, if it is clashing with your final year Graduation exam, then contact admission office with concerned documents as a proof of final exams. No other personal reasons will be entertained).

**10) Where will be the GD/PI centre?**

The only centre is the N.L. Dalmia Institute of Management Studies & Research, Mumbai for GD/PI.

**11) What is the application fee?**

The application fee is INR 2000/- per specialization. This fee can be paid online through Net banking, NEFT/RTGS, Credit card/Debit card payment or depositing cash at the institute's account office. All these details would be provided to you as you would apply for the program online on our website.

**12) Is there any cut-off score/ percentile for applying to PGDM program ?**

No, there is no cut-off for applying for PGDM.

**13) What is the last date of the form submission?**

The last date of applying for the program is 31<sup>st</sup> March 2019.

**14) What is the admission procedure?**

Selection will be based purely on merit, which will be evaluated out of 100 marks as below:

**15) What is the dress code for GD/PI process?**

The Dress code is business formals.

**16) What Original documents do I require during my GD/PI process?**

Following original documents are required during GD/PI process:

1. Written Test Score Card (CAT/XAT/CMAT/MH-CET/MAT/ATMA)
2. Class Xth Mark sheet
3. Class XIIth Mark sheet
4. Last Year Graduation Mark Sheet (If you are applying for final year exams, provide with latest exam Mark sheet)
5. Convocation Degree and Passing Certificate
6. Work Experience Certificate as applicable.
7. Extra-Curricular Activities Certificate if any (District Level, State Level, National Level etc).

**17) Do we need to carry photocopies also for all the mark sheet for GD/PI?**

No need to carry photocopies, just carry your originals for document verification.

**18) Do we need to take our CV for GD/PI?**

You may bring your updated CV for GD/PI process.

**19) When will the result of admission be declared?**

The date of PGDM admission results will be communicated at the time of GD-PI process. Usually the results are declared within a week after the last date of the entire GD-PI process. The results will be available on the institute notice board as well as on website.

**20) What is the fee structure of the program?**

Fees for the current year PGDM batch i.e. 2018-20 is INR 4.35 lakhs per annum which sums up to INR 8.7 lakhs for a 2 year full time program.

**21) What is the average & highest placement package?**

As per the placement records:  
The Average Salary is INR 6-7 Lakhs p.a.  
And the Highest Package offered is INR 24 Lakhs p.a.

**22) Name some companies who are your placement partners?**

**23) Do you have tie up with banks for education loans?**

Yes, students can avail loans at competitive terms from leading education loan providers such as Axis Bank, HDFC Credila & Avanse. The preferential terms are the same as offered for NLDIMSR and other leading B – Schools.

**24) Is hostel facility available?**

There is no on-campus hostel facility available but NLDIMSR arranges flats on rent near the institute for outstation students or students staying far-off in Mumbai. If the student wants to avail this facility, the admissions department has to be informed about the same during the admission process.

**25) What is the procedure for Institute level seats?**

NLDIMSR does not have any institute level seats. Selection for the PGDM program is done strictly on merit basis.
